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Duties of a Member of the U.S. House of Representatives:

A congressman's responsibilities include representing constituents, drafting and voting on legislation, overseeing government actions, and participating in national policy decisions. Congressmen are primarily responsible for **creating, debating, and passing laws** that affect the nation. This involves introducing bills, reviewing them in committees, debating on the floor, amending proposals, and voting on legislation.
